

As a member of the Greensboro College community, I recognize that I have a personal responsibility to do my part to keep myself and our Pride Community healthy and strong. Doing so demonstrates my commitment to our larger Greensboro College community. We are all One Pride!

I COMMIT TO:

PROTECTING MYSELF

- Perform daily health checks and seek medical guidance immediately if I have a fever of 100.5 or higher, dry cough, difficulty breathing, loss of taste or smell or other symptoms of COVID-19
- Wash my hands regularly with soap and water and use hand sanitizer when available
- Keep my personal and shared community space clean
- Get vaccinated for the flu in the fall of 2020 (NC legal exemptions apply)

PROTECTING OTHERS

- Wear a face covering inside all campus buildings including offices, classrooms, student spaces and residence halls and outside when I am not able to maintain a six-foot social distance from others. I will keep a face mask on my person at all times.
- Maintain appropriate physical distance
- Stay home if I do not feel well, have a known exposure to COVID-19 or am directed to do so by a Health or College Official

PROTECTING THE PRIDE

- Participate in testing and contact tracing as directed by Health or College Officials
- Follow any guidance or directives from Health or College Officials, which may include quarantining for up to 2-weeks in an assigned space
- Stay informed and monitor College News and Email regularly
- Follow all state and city regulations even when I am off-campus in regards to social distancing, mask wearing and limits on gatherings

ADDITIONAL RESIDENCE HALL POLICIES

- No visitors are allowed at any time. You may not host non-GC visitors on-campus and only those residents and staff who work in a specific hall will be permitted entry. Other GC students are not allowed to visit buildings in which they do not live.
- With guidance from the Guilford County Public Health, students who are exposed to a known case of COVID-19 or who become ill will be asked to return home. If a student is unable to travel or has other extenuating circumstances, a limited number of quarantine and isolation spaces are available on campus.
- Students who are unable to return home and are subsequently in isolation and/or quarantined on campus are expected to follow all College Officials' directives for health monitoring and safety and must remain in their assigned space. Accommodations such as meals and regular health checks by assigned monitors will be part of the on-campus quarantine protocol.

I understand that not abiding by these behaviors and expectations can have an impact on both our community and me personally. For the College to remain open and provide an in-person learning experience, we must all be committed to keeping ourselves and others safe. Personally, I could face disciplinary action which could include the loss of on-campus housing or potential removal from the Greensboro College Community. Students removed from halls or campus for disciplinary reasons are not entitled to a refund of any tuition, fees, or room and board charges per the Greensboro College Academic Catalog.
